Dear Mr. Isley:

The proposed roadway will pass through the southern section of a recreational field located west of Airport Road (State Route 526) and north of the Purdue Airport. This field is owned by the Trustees of Purdue University, and is used only by Purdue University students for softball, soccer, flag football, and other recreational activities.

Because of its size, the recreational field can be used simultaneously for many athletic events. Lights are being installed on the center section of this field in order to make use of the area during the evening hours. The lighting project significantly increases the number of events which can be scheduled on this field and more than offsets any loss of playing time which will occur when the field size is reduced by the proposed roadway.
