
Dear Mr. Tomak:

On September 13, 1991, ARMS received a letter from Mr. David Isley of Bernardin, Lochmueller & Associates, Inc. concerning a new alignment for Project F-071-2(001); US 231 realignment in Tippecanoe County. ARMS was asked to review documentation of our prior archaeological survey in the vicinity of the new alignment to determine if the proposed new alignment had been previously covered.

We reviewed our field notes and maps and found that the new alignment was previously covered during both field survey and subsurface reconnaissance. No sites were recorded directly within the new alignment. It is our recommendation that planning for use of the new alignment proceed without additional archaeological assessment.
